



RODOFITE SHAWL

Yarn: "**Fresco**" - Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze



Rodofite is a particular red seaweed, which lives beyond 100 meters deep. The red pigment uses the blue light, which penetrates very deeply into the water to take energy for photosynthesis.

As soon as I started working this yarn, I immediately thought of the algae, to their movement into the deep sea; the color made me think red seaweed.

MATERIAL:

Circular Knitting Needles 6 mm - 40 cm L
Yarn: "Fresco " Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze: 50 gr.

STITCHES:

K: KNIT

YO: yarn over

K2Tog: knit 2 sts together

R: Row/s

ELASTIC CAST OFF: K2, *pass sts from right needle to left n. and K2Tog, K1*, repeat till the end of bind off.

EXECUTIONS:

Cast on 3 sts - K accross

R1- K1, YO, K accross

R2-6 K accross

Repeat R1-R6 for 11 times, until you have 14 sts.

R7- K1, YO, K2, YO, K accross;

R8-12- K accross

Repeat R7-R12 for 5 times, until you have 24 sts.

R13- K1, YO, K2, YO, K2, YO - K accross

R14-18- knit accross

Repeat R13-R18 for 8 times, until you have 48 sts.

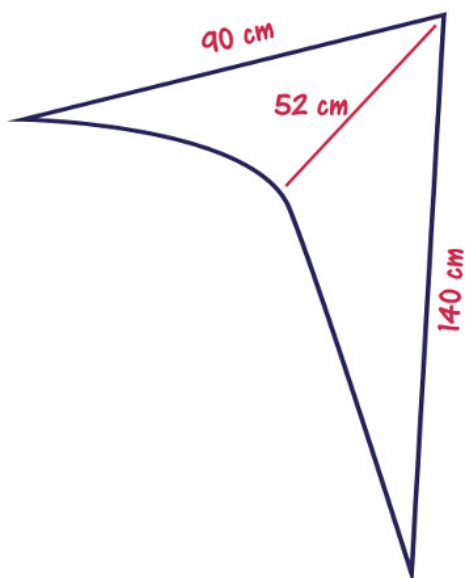
R19- K1, YO, K2, YO, K2, YO, K2, YO - Knit accross

R20-24- Knit accross

Repeat R19-R24 for 11 times, until you have 92 sts.

Elastic Cast-off

Weave-in all ends and block as follows:



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
